## INCIDENT SUMMARY

<b>Incident Summary:</b>	<p>At approximately 7:27 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a structure fire in a residence on the 20200 block of Bonnie Brae Way in Saratoga, with a resident unable to get out of the structure.</p> <p>On arrival, firefighters found a two story, single family residence with smoke coming from the front and fire extending to the rear of the home. Firefighters immediately made entry into the structure, rescued one resident and assisted a second resident out of the structure. Both were transported to an area hospital, one with minor injuries and the other as a precaution.</p> <p>A second alarm was requested and the fire was brought under control within approximately 20 minutes. The residence sustained fire damage to a majority of the living spaces and smoke and water damage throughout. Firefighters were able to prevent the spread of fire to adjacent residences or vegetation. The two residents displaced by the fire are receiving support from Red Cross.</p> <p>The cause of the fire is under investigation. Crews will remain on scene to for full extinguishment and overhaul.</p>
