INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:	At approximately 10:56 pm Santa Clara County firefighters were dispatched to the report of a vehicle off the roadway on Highway 9 just west of Redwood Gulch Road, west of Saratoga. Firefighters arrived and found a single vehicle off the roadway and up against a tree. The sole occupant of the vehicle was trapped inside. Using hydraulic rescue tools it took firefighters approximately 1-hour to extricate the young, male adult patient. The patient was then transported to an awaiting Cal Star helicopter and flown to a local trauma center. The patient had life threatening injuries. CHP is the investigating agency.
