## INCIDENT SUMMARY

<b>Incident Summary:</b>	<p>At approximately 6:01 p.m. firefighters at the El Monte fire station heard a vehicle accident outside the fire station. Firefighters went outside and found a vehicle had driven into a masonry wall attached to the fire station.</p> <p>Firefighters treated the only occupant of the vehicle, an elderly male. He was transported to Stanford University Hospital in serious condition. It is unknown at this time whether his condition was a result of the vehicle accident or he suffered a medical emergency prior to the collision.</p> <p>No firefighters were injured and the fire station did not receive any structural damage.</p>
