INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:

Just after 5:00 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department responded to reports of an apartment fire in a multi-unit complex. Upon arrival, crews found a two-story four-unit apartment building with smoke and fire showing from the first floor and extending into the second floor.

A second alarm was called and crews initiated a search of all units, confirming that all residents had evacuated the building safely.

The fire was brought under control within fifteen minutes, preventing spread of the fire to an adjacent complex. Four units were damaged, displaced residents are receiving assistance from Red Cross.

The cause of the fire is under investigation, crews remain on scene for full extinguishment and clean up.
