

Community Wildfire Protection Plan Workshops

Wildfire Protection Plan Will Help Protect Your Home and the Environment!

Santa Clara County Fire Department asks residents to attend a workshop to share local knowledge, propose projects, and offer suggested prioritization for the drafted Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP).

The CWPP is a collaborative approach for reducing wildland fire risks to communities and the environment. The plan will include an analysis of conditions such as fire apparatus access, fuels, topography, and weather. The focus will be on the structures that intermingle with wildland vegetation. Once complete, the countywide CWPP will be updated periodically to reflect the current risk communities are threatened with as conditions warrant.

Residents are encouraged to attend one of the community workshops being offered in May.
