

Sandbag Locations

Meteorologists continue to warn of forecasted raging rainstorms and flooding during this winter's El Niño that will affect the Bay Area and much of California. According to the California Geological Survey, drought-dried and fire-scarred landscapes as well as hills and mountains of the Bay

Area are vulnerable to mudslides.

Predictions for heavy rain call for 120% above average precipitation through January with 140% above average during the months of February and March.

In preparation for these winter storms, the Santa Clara Valley Water District and many local public works departments have increased the availability of sandbags.
