INCIDENT SUMMARY	
Incident Summary:	<p>Just after 2:00 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a vegetation fire along Northbound Freeway 85 in Cupertino. Upon arrival, crews found active fire burning in the median area and right shoulder of the Northbound Highway 280 to Northbound Freeway 85 interchange. Crews controlled the fire in approximately 20 minutes. The cause of the fire is under investigation, but not considered suspicious.</p> <p>The fire burned dry grass along the roadway and sound wall, crews remained on scene for full extinguishment and cleanup. California Highway Patrol temporarily closed the Northbound 280 to Northbound 85 ramp, all roadways were reopened following the incident.</p> <p>Much of the grasses and vegetation in Santa Clara County that followed the wet winter are now dry and susceptible to fire. Be aware of fire safety when traveling roadways; Do not dispose of cigarettes outside of your vehicle, ensure tow chains are not dragging and do not pull your vehicle over into dry grass.
