INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:

At approximately 2:20 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a male subject in the Los Gatos Creek. The first arriving engine found a single patient on a steep concrete slope of the creek, near a 'spillway' in the area of the Camden Ave./San Tomas Expressway overpass. The patient had been removed from the water by citizen bystanders.

A technical rope rescue system was used to secure and safely remove the patient from the concrete embankment. The patient was transported to a local hospital by Santa Clara County EMS in stable condition.

Santa Clara County Fire Department reminds residents to always be cautious around moving water and keep a safe distance during high water flows. Even calm areas of creeks and rivers can be dangerous.
