INSTRUCTIONAL GUIDE

Topic: XSC Strike Team Communications Drill

Purpose:

To exercise the use of each departments mutual aid radios within a Strike Team situation.

Materials Needed:

- 1. Santa Clara County Local Fire Service and Rescue Mutual Aid Plan, Appendix 1
- 2. VHF portable radios with common mutual aid channel programming, one for each crewmember. IE: Bendix King and or other out of county radios used.
- 3. VHF mobile radio with common mutual aid channel programming, one per vehicle.
- 4. Departmental reference/guide for your particular type/brand of radios.
- Time:30 to 60 minutes

Desired Outcomes:

- 1. Given any common mutual aid channel by the Strike Team Leader, personnel will be able to communicate over their departments issued radios.
- 2. Personnel should be able to utilize the Santa Clara County Local Fire and Rescue Mutual Aid Plan Appendix 1 for radio programming or reference if needed.

Key Components:

- The drill will comprise of the Strike Team Leader assigning crews with a common mutual aid VHF channel from the Santa Clara Local Fire Service and Rescue Mutual Aid Plan Appendix 1, and then conduct a PAR with each crew. Both types of radios will be utilized, portable and mobile.
- The portable radio drill will be conducted twice, first using a COMMAND channel, then a TACTICAL channel. The Strike Team Leader may utilize his/her local agency channels if available.
- The mobile radio drill will be conducted on CESRS DIRECT (transmit and receive frequency of 153.755 MHz, No CTCSS tone.).
- 4. Chosen common VHF mutual aid channel should be monitored prior to drill use. Do not cause interference to an actual event.
