INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:	<p>Just before midnight on Sunday, September 27, Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a structure fire on the 20600 block of Cheryl Drive in Cupertino.</p> <p>On arrival, firefighters found a two-story single family residence heavily involved in fire, and a second alarm was requested. Five occupants were in the home at the time of the fire and had evacuated safely.</p> <p>Firefighters were able to prevent the spread of the fire to neighboring residences and brought it under control at approximately 1:00 a.m. The home sustained fire damage throughout, displacing all occupants. The residents were not injured and did not require assistance from Red Cross.</p> <p>Crews remained on scene until almost 5:30 a.m. for full extinguishment and cleanup. The cause of the fire is under investigation.</p>
