Incident Summary:	Just after 2:00 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a vegetation fire along Northbound Freeway 85 in Cupertino. Upon arrival, crews found active fire burning in the median area and right shoulder of the Northbound Highway 280 to Northbound Freeway 85 interchange. Crews controlled the fire in approximately 20 minutes. The cause of the fire is under investigation, but not considered suspicious.
