	INCIDENT SUMMARY
Incident Summary:	At approximately 10:07 a.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department responded to multiple reports of a vegetation fire in the area of the Los Gatos Creek Trail and Camden Avenue in Campbell.
	Crews were able to make access to the fire from the East side of the Creek Trail, and from Highway 17. Forward progress of the fire was stopped within approximately 30 minutes and the fire was contained at 11:33 a.m; The fire burned approximately 1/4 acre.
	No homes were threatened by the fire and no injuries were reported. Firefighters remained on-scene until shortly after 12:30 p.m. for full extinguishment and cleanup. Cause of the fire is under investigation.
