	INCIDENT SUMMARY
Incident Summary:	Just after 3:00 a.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to multiple reports of an explosion and structure fire on the 1800 block of Grant Park Lane in Los Altos
	On arrival, firefighters found a fire on the exterior of a residence, involving an actively leaking residential gas meter. Los Altos Police Department safely evacuated the residents in the affected home, as well as 6 other residences in the area as a precaution.  Firefighters were able to safely clamp the gas line feeding the meter, and extinguish the fire, in under 40 minutes. The residence sustained fire damage to the outside of
	the home, but crews were able to prevent its spread to the inside of the structure.  No injuries were reported and no residents were displaced by the fire.
	The cause of the fire is not considered suspicious and is under investigation in cooperation with PG&E.
