	INCIDENT SUMMARY
Incident Summary:	Just after 10:30 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a structure fire in a residence on the 1600 block of Hacienda Avenue in Campbell. On arrival, firefighters found a two story, singe family residence with two residents waiting outside. Neighbors on-scene reported hearing a loud sound and seeing a fire on the second floor. Upon investigation, firefighters found smoke coming from a second floor bedroom to the rear of the home. Crews made entry into the structure, and were able to quickly contain the fire to the single bedroom.
	The residence sustained fire damage to the second floor bedroom and smoke and water damage to approximately 25% of the home. One occupant sustained minor smoke-related injuries, but declined medical attention at the scene. The two residents displaced by the fire did not require assistance.
	Crews remained on scene through the early morning hours for extensive cleanup. The cause of the fire is under investigation.
	Santa Clara County Fire Department reminds residents to always have a way out when attempting to extinguish a small fire in the home. If a fire grows or is too big to safely extinguish, evacuate immediately and call 9-1-1.
