INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:

At approximately 5:48 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to reports of a structure fire in a commercial building on the 100 block of West Hamilton Avenue in Campbell.

Crews arrived to find a fire in a restaurant with heavy smoke coming out of the front door. Crews aggressively attacked the fire, protecting neighboring occupancies within the same structure. A second alarm was called to assist with fire attack and property conservation. The restaurant suffered heavy smoke and fire damage, with smoke and water damage extending to a neighboring occupancy. Two other occupancies in the structure did not suffer any damage, however all businesses at the address will remain closed until cleared by the City of Campbell Building inspector. The cause of the fire is under investigation, but is not considered suspicious. Crews will remain on scene to complete extinguishment and overhaul.

Santa Clara County Fire Department reminds all business owners and community members to ensure cooking areas remain clean and free of flammable materials. Smoke alarms, sprinkler systems, and other fire safety devices should be maintained and inspected according to applicable codes and manufacturer recommendations. All community members are reminded to know two ways out of every room, and evacuate promptly in case of fire.

Road Closures:

Lanes of eastbound W. Hamilton Ave closed during the fire fight have reopened.
