## INCIDENT SUMMARY

### Incident Summary:

Just before 5:00 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a structure fire on the 19000 block of Harleigh Drive in Saratoga.

On arrival, firefighters found smoke coming from a single story residence. Three occupants were in the home at the time of the fire and had evacuated safely. Firefighters were able to keep the fire confined to the kitchen area and brought it under control within 20 minutes. The residence sustained fire and smoke damage to the kitchen.

The residents did not require assistance from Red Cross and the cause of the fire is under investigation, but is likely unintentional due to an unattended pot on the stove.

According to the National Fire Protection Association, the leading cause of fires in the kitchen is unattended cooking. Santa Clara County Fire Department reminds residents to always monitor food cooking on a stovetop. If you have a small grease fire, smother the flames with a lid and shut off the stove. Do not attempt to douse the fire with water.

If you have any doubt about fighting a small fire, evacuate the home and call 9-1-1.
