INCIDENT SUMMARY	
Incident Summary:	At approximately 3:52 p.m., the Santa Clara County Fire Department and Cal Fire were dispatched to multiple reports of a vegetation fire along Highway 17 near the intersection of Idylwild Road.
	On arrival, crews found a vegetation fire in dry grass adjacent to the roadway. Firefighters were able to stop forward progress of the fire within approximately 40 minutes and prevent it from threatening homes in the area.
	The fire burned approximately 0.25 acres; there were no injuries to firefighters or residents and no structures were damaged. The cause of the fire is under investigation and is potentially suspicious in nature. Crews will remain on scene for full extinguisment.
	This incident illustrates the value of fuel reduction efforts in our communities. The Highway 17 Shaded Fuel Break aided firefighters in stopping this fire before it could endanger lives and property.
Road Closures:	Highway 17 southbound closures remain in effect
