INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:	<p>At approximately 6:20 a.m. Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a report of a structure fire on Lovell Avenue in the City of Campbell. On arrival, firefighters found a fire in the attic. Occupants of the home had already evacuated and were able to communicate to firefighters that everyone was out of the structure. Firefighters worked quickly to control the fire in the attic, controlling the fire in less than 15 minutes. Crews began salvage operations immediately to limit smoke and fire damage and protect personal property in the home.</p> <p>All community members are reminded to have working smoke alarms in their home and test them once a month. At the very least, there should be a smoke alarm on every level of the home, in each bedroom, and outside of every sleeping area. Additionally, community members should have an escape plan, including two ways out of each room and a safe meeting place away from the structure.
