INCIDENT SUMMARY	
Incident Summary:	<p>At approximately 7:14 a.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a reported structure fire on the 1300 block of Munro Avenue in Campbell.</p> <p>On arrival, firefighters found smoke coming from the eaves of a single story residence. One occupant was confirmed to be inside and crews immediately entered the structure and rescued the resident who was uninjured.</p> <p>The fire was brought under control within 20 minutes. The residence sustained fire damage to the attic and kitchen area, and smoke and water damage to additional portions of the home.</p> <p>One resident was displaced by the fire and is receiving assistance from Red Cross. The cause of the fire is under investigation, but is not considered suspicious.</p>
