INCIDENT SUMMARY	
Incident Summary:	<p>At approximately 4:52 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to reports of a fire on the hillside in the area of the 15000 block of Oak Knoll Drive in the Town of Los Gatos.</p> <p>On arrival, crews found an approximately ½ acre vegetation fire in dry grass and oaks, threatening one adjacent structure. Firefighters were able to contain the fire within approximately 20 minutes and prevent it from threatening additional homes in the area.</p> <p>The fire burned a total of 1 acre; there were no injuries to firefighters or residents and no structures were damaged. Cause of the fire is under investigation but is not considered suspicious, and crews remain on scene for full extinguishment.</p> <p>Recent mowing of seasonal grass and well maintained trees, creating defensible space for numerous homes, contributed to the ability for crews to quickly contain the fire. Santa Clara County Fire Department reminds residents to ensure their property has 100 feet of defensible space around the home. Mowing and use of spark-producing equipment should be completed in the morning hours before hotter and drier afternoon conditions increase fire danger. More info at sccfd.org/rsg.</p>
