INCIDENT SUMMARY

Incident Summary:	<p>Just before 4:00 p.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a reported vegetation fire outside of a residence in the area of the 15800 block of Shannon Road in Los Gatos.</p> <p>On arrival, crews found a small 30 x 30 foot area of grass burning at a moderate rate, threatening the adjacent residence. Firefighters were able to quickly contain the fire within approximately 10 minutes of arrival. No structures were damaged and no injuries were reported.</p> <p>The cause of the fire is under investigation but is not considered suspicious.</p> <p>Although the fire was kept to 1/10 acre, the fire is a reminder that fire season has arrived in Santa Clara County and just one spark could have dangerous consequences. With hot and dry conditions expected through the upcoming weekend, residents are reminded not to use equipment that could produce a spark during the afternoon hours when grasses and brush are at their driest.</p> <p>For more information on preparing your home and family for wildfire, visit sccfd.org/rsg</p>
