	INCIDENT SUMMARY
Incident Summary:	At approximately 9:24 a.m. Santa Clara County Fire Department (SCCFD) received a report of possible fentanyl exposure at Los Altos Police Department. Fentanyl is a strong, synthetic narcotic that is estimated to be 80-100 times stronger than morphine. Consequently, exposure to minute amounts that can occur when coming into contact with people or items that have been contaminated by the substance, can lead to serious health effects such as slowed respirations, reduced blood pressure, and loss of consciousness.
	Out of an abundance of caution, one police officer was evaluated for non-life- threatening symptoms and transported to the hospital for further evaluation.
	The SCCFD hazardous materials team is working with the Los Altos Police Department to ensure the substance is isolated and the facility is safe.
