## INCIDENT SUMMARY

### Incident Summary:

Just after 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday night, Santa Clara County Fire Department responded to a report of a vehicle over the side of Highway 9, near the intersection of Highway 35. Upon arrival, crews found a vehicle approximately 300 feet down a steep embankment with one patient in the vehicle.

The steep terrain and distance from the roadway required rescuers to use rope systems to reach the patient, remove them from the vehicle, and safely haul them back to the roadway.

The patient was transported by Santa Clara County EMS to an area hospital with minor injuries.
