## INCIDENT SUMMARY

### Incident Summary:

Just after 8:00 a.m., Santa Clara County Fire Department was dispatched to a reported fire alarm at Fisher Middle School in Los Gatos. Upon arrival, crews found light smoke inside a detached portable building on the school campus.

A smouldering fire in the building's ventilation (HVAC) unit was quickly extinguished and crews confirmed that the fire had not spread to additional areas of the building. The portable structure sustained minor damage to the ventilation unit and ceiling tiles that were removed for firefighter access.

The cause of the fire is under investigation but is not considered suspicious.

School was not yet in session at the time of the call and firefighters on scene worked with the school administration to confirm that any students present had been evacuated from the school buildings and were accounted for.

Direct communications were made from the school district to parents and staff, and school resumed once crews confirmed there was no further hazard.
