	INCIDENT SUMMARY
Incident Summary:	At 6:12 p.m. firefighters were dispatched to the area of Old Santa Cruz Highway at Wright Drive, near the southwest side of Lexington Reservoir, for the report of a juvenile stuck in the mud. Upon arrival, crews found a 12-year old male, approximately 300 yeards from the roadway, with one leg encased in mud, up to the knee.  Crews were able to dig around the limb to relieve the suction of the mud and extricate the individual just before 7:00 p.m. Crews assisted the individual back to the roadway, where he was transferred to Santa Clara County EMS and transported to an area hospital as a precaution.  When near waterways or in areas impacted by inclement weather, Santa Clara County Fire Department reminds residents to be aware of footings and avoid crossing areas of mud that can pose an entrapment hazard.
